

Award in Education and Training Level 3 (for International Students)

Entry Requirements

No formal entry requirements but students may find it useful if they already have a Level 2 qualification. You must possess English language skills appropriate for the course. A full initial assessment will be carried out at the start of the course to identify any needs you may have.

Aim

This is an introductory teaching qualification which can help students to start teaching in an FE (College) environment.

Course Content

For those students interested in working in teaching and/or training within the Further Education and skills sector, this qualification provides a comprehensive introduction. Students will explore teaching roles and responsibilities, reflect on appropriate teaching and learning approaches, and plan, deliver and evaluate micro-teaching sessions or assessed practice in a real work environment.

Students will complete this qualification with a concrete understanding of the following: The roles, responsibilities and relationships in education and training.

Optional units include: Understanding and Using Inclusive Teaching and Learning Approaches in Education and Training, Facilitate Learning and Development in Groups, and more.

Typically 2 days a week for 6 weeks
