Entry Requirements

No formal entry requirements. Learners may find it useful if they already have a Level 1 qualification. You must possess English language skills appropriate for the course. A full initial assessment will be carried out at the start of the course to identify any needs you may have.

Aim

An introduction to the knowledge and understanding needed to work in a school/college environment, applying to the many varied roles that support staff may fulfil including: administrative roles, site support roles, technical roles and volunteers, as well as roles that work directly with children and young people in the learning environment.
